MSc in Facade Engineering

Examination regulations

- 1 These regulations supplement the University Examination Regulations.
- 2 Candidates must achieve a minimum mark of 40% to pass a taught Module
- 3 At the discretion of the Board of Examiners, candidates who fail to achieve a pass mark of 40% at the first assessment of a taught module may be allowed to be assessed on that failed module on one further occasion.
- 4 Marks awarded at first assessment are those that will be applied to Aggregated marks.
- 5 Candidates who fail more than two modules at the first assessment will be ineligible for the Diploma or the MSc.
- 6 Candidates who pass a taught module, and do not pass to the Diploma or MSc, will be eligible for the award of a Postgraduate Certificate for the passed module or modules.
- 7 Candidates who pass all taught modules at first assessment will be eligible for the Diploma in Facade Engineering.
- 8 Candidates who fail no more than two taught modules at first assessment, but go on to pass the failed taught modules on re-assessment will be eligible for the Diploma in Facade Engineering.
- 9 Candidates who pass all taught modules at first assessment and achieve an aggregate average mark of 50% or more will be allowed to progress to dissertation.
- 10 Candidates who fail no more than two taught modules at first assessment, but go on to pass the failed taught modules on re-assessment and achieve an aggregated average mark of 50% or more on all taught modules will be allowed to progress to dissertation.
- 11 To be eligible for the award of a MSc degree in Facade Engineering, Candidates must pass both the taught part of the course and the dissertation.
- 12 Candidates who achieve a mark of 40% or more for the dissertation will be eligible for the award of MSc in Facade Engineering.
- 13 Candidates who fail to achieve a mark of 40% for their dissertation at first submission may, at the discretion of the Board of Examiners, be allowed to re-submit the dissertation on one occasion for re-assessment. Candidates who re-submit the dissertation and achieve a mark of 40% or more will be eligible for the award of MSc in Facade Engineering.
- 14 Candidates who achieve a mark of 70% or above in each taught module and achieve a mark of 70% or above in the dissertation, will be eligible for the award of MSc in Facade Engineering with distinction.
